WABANAKI POLICY YOUTH INITIATIVE



Youth coordinators from Maine Environmental Education Association and the Wabanaki Alliance are partnering during the upcoming legislative session to offer an exciting opportunity for Wabanaki youth, ages 16 to 22.

Youth involved will have the chance to experience the state lawmaking process firsthand through the tracking of three priority bills related to Wabanaki sovereignty.

They will receive mentorship from other Wabanaki citizens who are experts in the policy field, and youth will also meet regularly as a group to plan outreach and build materials and resources to further educate Maine youth on critical Wabanaki issues and the general lawmaking process.
